# The Breeder agrees:

- ✓ The hedgehog will be of good weight 180g+ at the time of leaving the breeders care.
- ✓ The hedgehog will be no younger than 7 weeks of age at the time of leaving.
- ✓ The hedgehog will not leave the breeders care with any signs of ill health. (If a hedgehog shows signs of ill health then the breeder will hold it back until well.)

- ✓ The hedgehog will leave fully registered with one of the standing registries at the time.
- ✓ The hedgehog will leave with change over food and lifetime support at a minimum, (carepack choices also available).

## The owner agrees:

- ✓ To house the hedgehog in a suitable home no less than 4.5 square feet in floor space.
- ✓ To provide a safe and constant heat source.
- ✓ To provide a diet consisting of high quality dry food, live insects and avoid known dangerous foods.
- ✓ To provide fresh drinking water at all times.
- √ To provide a running wheel no smaller in diameter than 11" and with a solid running surface, (no wire wheels).
- ✓ To provide a substrate suitable for sensitive respiratory systems.
- ✓ To maintain good levels of hygiene in the hedgehogs environment.
- ✓ To regularly trim nails and inspect the hedgehogs physical health.
- √ To ensure there is a back up care giver incase of emergencies.
- ✓ To register the hedgehog with a vet capable of treating hedgehogs. This should be done within first month of ownership and not left until an emergency situation.
- ✓ To inform the breeder of any future health concerns that may affect the breeders lines (I.e WHS).
- ✓ To inform and seek advice from the breeder for any difficulties the owner is having with care.
- ✓ To notify the breeder of any changes in address.
- ✓ To not purposefully cause harm, injury or distress to the hedgehog.

- ✓ To seek vet attention when needed.
- ✓ To love the hedgehog!
- ✓ To not breed the hedgehog without obtaining breeding rights, (separate contract) from the breeder first. This contract is for pet only unless combined with a 'Breeding rights' contract!

## Surrender or re-sale:

- ➤ The owner must get in touch with the breeder if they plan to surrender or re-sell the hedgehog.
- > The owner has the right to search for a new suitable home for the hedgehog but must obtain the breeders approval before exchange.
- If a suitable home cannot be found or agreed upon, the breeder may accept the return of the hedgehog but will not be obliged to provide any monetary compensation.
- ➤ In the case of the hedgehog being returned to the breeder, the breeder <u>may</u> offer full or part refunds in the following circumstances...
  - 1. The hedgehog is under 6 months.
  - 2. The contract remains unbroken by the owner.
  - 3. A vet certificate is provided with evidence that the hedgehog is of ill health as a breeder fault or bad practice, this does not include WHS (which would be unknown to the breeder).

This contract is legally binding. If the owner fails to meet the care requirements required or in anyway breaks this contract, the breeder will issue a formal warning in writing. A second breach in contract gives the breeder the right to seize the

hedgehog without refund. If the owner refuses access to the breeder to seize the hedgehog, legal aid will be sought.
